

There will be 12 sketchbook assignments due per semester for a total of 24 for the year. Each sketchbook drawing is a minimum of 30 minutes of continuous drawing for full credit and are graded based on completion. Sketchbooks are checked every 4 sketchbooks (monthly) and if sketchbooks are not completed at that time then they can be turned in *for up to half credit* at the end of the sketchbook cycle. Please use a photographic reference or real life and a pencil.


Follow the weeks and choose ONE BULLET POINT between the options based on what you think you need to improve on most, or the most interesting prompt (choose more if it takes you less than 30 minutes). BE DETAILED! A fast drawing cannot be disguised as anything else.

Label each sketchbook with the chosen drawing and the week (ex: Sketchbook Week 3-Instruction manual for a fanny pack).


Semester One:

Sketchbook Week 1: <i>Observations:</i> Packet 1 DUE 9/23	 Just before your room is cleaned, draw it Draw the contents of your refrigerator Before the dishes are washed, draw them Draw a pile of laundry waiting to get washed
Sketchbook Week 2: <i>People:</i> <i>Packet 1 DUE 9/23</i>	 Draw a portrait inside out Draw a portrait of you and your friends as cards; the queen, king, and jack of spades Draw your family as insects in a family portrait Draw your portrait from the reflection of a shiny chrome object (ex: toaster, bowl, spoon)
Sketchbook Week 3: Imagination: Packet 1 DUE 9/23	 Dig a hole, put a whole in the hole, draw what is in the hole Fill in the hole, cover up the whole, draw the covered hole Draw an instruction manual on the Macarena Draw an instruction manual for a fanny pack
Sketchbook Week 4: <i>Food:</i> <i>Packet 1 DUE 9/23</i>	 Draw raw chicken parts; cooked parts; after eaten parts Draw a form fitting case made of steel that would fit an apple, pear, banana Draw a form fitted case made of wood and lined with velvet for an apple, pear, and a banana Draw the making of guacamole Draw boiling pasta



Sketchbook Week 5: Words or Phrases to Illustrate: Packet 2 DUE 10/28	 Make a drawing that illustrates the phrase "I have come to a juncture in my life" Make a drawing that illustrates the phrase "There is an insufficiency of intellect" Make a drawing that illustrates the word "Haste" Illustrate your favorite poem
Sketchbook Week 6: Hands: Packet 2 DUE 10/28	 Draw your hand against other parts of anatomy Draw the hands of a gardener (no tracing/turkeys) Draw your best friend's hands (no tracing/turkeys) Draw hands holding each other (no tracing/turkeys) Draw a-spelled-out word in ASL
Sketchbook Week 7: <i>Insects:</i> <i>Packet 2 DUE 10/28</i>	 Change the size relationship (scale) of the insect and something else (ex: building, ships, cars) Draw a small comic strip of two bugs cracking jokes Make a drawing of a cake decorated to be an insect, make it look delicious
Sketchbook Week 8: <i>Objects:</i> Packet 2 DUE 10/28	 Draw green army men (toy) Draw Barbie and Ken, Draw Barbie's accessories Make a drawing of a frozen object Draw a wet object, make it look slick
Sketchbook Week 9: <i>Nature:</i> <i>Packet 3 DUE 12/6</i>	 Draw a dead bird in a beautiful landscape Draw a flower growing next to a turned over garbage can Draw the view from a porch, looking out onto a countryside Make a drawing of horse pastures or horse pastors
Sketchbook Week 10: <i>Emulation:</i> Packet 3 DUE 12/6	 Copy any work of art older than you Draw Mona Lisa with a milk mustache Re-create a famous painting as a drawing Draw yourself in "The Scream" by Edvard Munch Draw your art teacher in "The Scream" by Edvard Munch




Semester Two:

Sketchbook Week 6: <i>Objects and Light:</i> Packet 2 DUE 3/20	 Shine a light through an open weave structure, draw the cast shadow Draw an object that is lit by the light coming through mini blinds Draw a portrait that is lit by the light coming through mini blinds Draw something lit from a flashlight
